## Jude (Contending for the Faith)

POINT: "What is the book about?"  It is about the acknowledgement of a sinister presence among "the beloved".
PURPOSE: "Why was the book written?"  To equip, direct & encourage those who are beloved by God to contend & continue in their most holy faith despite clandestine nefarious activity.
PRACTICAL APPLICATION: "How does this affect my life personally?
1. Note verse 4 states that "certain person have crept in" Verse 12 describes them as men who are reefs."
2. How would you describe the demeanor of such men? (vss. 8, 10, 16)
3. Though hidden from man they are clearly visible to God. What 5 examples does Hegive to affirm His ever present awareness and righteous judgment? (vss. 5 – 7, 11)
Why does He use these examples specifically?
4. If God will faithfully judge, what am I to do? (vss. 3, 17, 20-23)
