Philemon (Encouraging Reconciliation)

POINT: "What is the book about?" It is about the <u>acceptance</u> of one who <u>had</u> wronged <u>now</u> changed.
PURPOSE: "Why was the book written?" To demonstrate grace in the appealing of others to be gracious.
PRACTICAL APPLICATION: "How does this affect my life personally?
