Revelation (Overcoming the World)

POINT: "What is the book about?"

It is about the unveiling of the insatiable forces of darkness which permeate creation and the power of the Lamb to overcome them.

PURPOSE: "Why was the book written?"

To show the Church the way of victory (complete & final) over the <u>power</u> of sin.

PRACTICAL APPLICATION: "How does this affect my life personally?

- 1. Who is the letter from and whom is it written to? (1:9, 10; 22:16)
- 2. What does God want the church to do with this letter? (1:3)
- 3. How is this accomplished? That is to say, what is the repeated desire of Christ for all 7 churches? (2:7, 11, 17, 26; 3:5, 12, 21)
- 4. What desire should this letter stir within me as a part of the church? (6:10; 7:10; 11:15-17; 19:1-2, 7; 22:14, 17, 20)
- 5. How does the world feel about this? (15:18; 16:9, 11, 14, 21; 19:19)
- 6. What will ultimately be revealed in the final days? (15:3-4)
- 7. Who is the sovereign controller and clear victor in Revelation? (5:6-14; 6:1, 15-17; 7:9-10, 13-17; 11:15-17; 14:1-4; 15:2-4; 19:6-9, 11-16; 20:4-6; 21:22-27; 22:1-2)
