POINT: "What is the book about?" It is about establishing order in a disorderly world.

PURPOSE: "Why was the book written?"

To direct ministers as to how they should correct the antithetical testimony of disorderly conduct by the church.

PRACTICAL APPLICATION: "How does this affect my life personally?
