4 Reasons for Pre-Tribulation View of the Rapture:

Note: The Rapture and the 2nd Coming are not at the same time.

- 1. The Rapture is referred to as a mystery. The 2nd Coming is not a mystery.
- 2. There are distinct places of difference. I.e., Rapture takes place in the clouds. 2nd Coming takes place on earth.
- 3. Only believers are mentioned at the Rapture. The 2nd Coming is concerned mostly with unbelievers.
- 4. The Church is promised (Rev. 3:10) that they will be off the scene prior to this time of testing.
- 2 Peter 3:11-18- Note at least 7 things we are to be giving our attention to today.
