FELLOWSHIP GUIDELINES

All fellowship outings of the church, whether social or evangelistic must be cleared with an elder first, at which time the elder will appoint a fellowship coordinator or deacon for the task of overseeing the outing. Please remember that as with any fellowship time:

- 1. Above all, our 'fellowship is in Him' 1 John 1:3. Our primary purpose for meeting is to fellowship around the Lord Jesus Christ and to reach out to those who may not know Him.
- 2. In planning, bear in mind the needs of your group (young families have baby- sitting needs, elderly have a fixed income, etc.) It is better to have a few good times than several flops.
- 3. Do not have any activity that will interfere with attending our main services of worship.
- 4. Fellowship outings should not take the place of regular class time without approval of a Pastor except for special meetings (Missions Conference, etc.)
- 5. It is expected of all church members attending any fellowship outing that they behave in a "manner worthy of their calling....", to demonstrate the character of Christ in all speech, temperament, attire, gestures and personal discipline (abstaining from all vices). The Bible commands: "Whether you eat or drink or whatsoever you do, do all to the glory of God." 1 Corinthians 10:31
- 6. All outings will have a time in God's Word as we are convinced that it is the Word of God that changes people. All devotional material and teachers or guest speakers are to be pre-approved by Pastor, Elder or Deacon.
